- Overcoming fears, uncertainties and doubts
- How to make success sustainable

**Masterclass II: Four Faces of Leadership – expanding your repertoire, increasing your impact**  
11 September 2007

Under pressure most managers revert to their favourite leadership style. However, in an increasingly complex modern environment this habitual response can damage individuals, teams and organisations. This highly interactive and experiential workshop will give you the tools with which you can meet different leadership challenges appropriately.

This masterclass identifies four key leadership archetypes. We call them the “Four Faces of Leadership”; the Good King, the Medicine Woman, the Great Mother and the Warrior. Participants identify the character that they most wish to learn from and engage in practical exercises in these areas. Once these have been rehearsed in a safe learning environment they become accessible back in the workplace.

- Understanding positive and negative leadership potentials
- Learning to adapt leadership style depending on the situation
- Experiential exercises to “live” the characters
- Rehearsal techniques to practice and take away
- Small group coaching with expert coaches to imbed the learning

The masterclasses can be attended separately although leaders will gain maximum benefit from attending both. Leaders who can inspire themselves and others while adapting their style to meet each challenge appropriately will substantially increase their impact and effectiveness. Due to the small group coaching component of the “Four Faces of Leadership” there are a limited number of places available. Please book early to avoid disappointment.
